AUTHORIZING THE HIRING OF CERTAIN CRITICAL POSITIONS AND AMENDING THE 2011 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS BUDGET

By Personnel and Audit and Finance Committees:

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 441 for 2009, this Honorable Body established a hiring freeze in Albany County, and

WHEREAS, This Honorable Body recognizes the need to hire employees to fill critical and necessary positions, however, before a person is hired, the decision to hire needs to be reviewed and approved by a designated legislative committee, and

WHEREAS, The Albany County Department of Public Works has requested authorization to amend its 2011 Stormwater Coalition Budget to create a Technical/Administrative Assistant-GIS/GPS position, which will be funded by the Water Quality Improvement Project Grant, and

WHEREAS, The Audit and Finance and Personnel Committees have reviewed the aforementioned position and have approved said position as meeting the critical and necessary criteria established in Resolution No. 441, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the following position is authorized to be filled and the 2011 Department of Public Works Budget is amended as necessary for said purpose:

Decrease Appropriation Account A8021 4 by \$21,460 by decreasing Line Item A8021 4 4046 Fees for Services by \$21,460

Increase Appropriation Account A8021 1 by \$15,000 by creating and increasing Line Item A8021 1 2718 001 Technical/Administrative Assistant-GIS/GPS by \$15,000 for fiscal year 2011 with an annual salary of \$30,000

Increase Appropriation Account A8021 8 by \$6,460 by increasing the following line items:

Increase Line Item A8021 8 9010 State Retirement by \$1,785

Increase Line Item A8021 8 9030 Social Security by \$1,148

Increase Line Item A8021 8 9060 Hospital and Medical Insurance by \$3,527

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
