## AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY REGARDING GRANT FUNDING FOR TERRORISM PREVENTION VEHICLES AND AMENDING THE 2011 SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT BUDGET

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff's Department has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the New York State Office of Homeland Security in the amount of \$534,756 regarding grant funding for Terrorism Prevention Vehicles for the period commencing August 1, 2010 and ending July 31, 2013, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that the funding would be used to purchase a Mobil Command Center and a Tactical Intervention Vehicle to respond to Law Enforcement incidents such as a bomb threat or a post blast incident, as well as act as a redundant emergency operations center in the event a catastrophe shuts down the County Emergency Operations Center, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff also requested a budget amendment in order to incorporate the aforementioned funding into the 2011 budget, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the New York State Office of Homeland Security in the amount of \$534,756 regarding grant funding for Terrorism Prevention Vehicles for the period commencing August 1, 2010 and ending July 31, 2013, and, be it further

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the 2011 Sheriff's Department Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A3306 Homeland Security by \$534,756

Increase Appropriation Account A3110 2 by increasing Line Item A3110 2 2750 Security Equipment by \$534,756

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
