AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS WITH BROOME AND ONEIDA COUNTIES REGARDING MENTORING SERVICES IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE COMMUNITY LIVING GRANT

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Aging has requested authorization to enter into intermunicipal agreements with Broome and Oneida Counties, and

WHEREAS, The 100% Federal grant pass through funding in the amount of \$3,750 for each contract will provide mentoring services for the Albany County Departments for Aging and Social Services in conjunction with the Community Living Program commencing September 30, 2010 and ending September 29, 2011, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to execute intermunicipal agreements with Broome and Oneida Counties regarding mentoring services in conjunction with the Community Living Grant in the amount of \$3,750 for each contract commencing September 30, 2010 and ending September 29, 2011, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
