WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Aging has been notified by the NYS Office for the Aging that funds are available for various supportive service programs for seniors in Albany County, and

WHEREAS, Said programs provide transportation, adult day care services, case management, preventive health services, shopping assistance and supportive services for families of elderly victims of Alzheimer's disease and to low income elderly persons, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging in the amount of \$332,673 commencing January 1, 2011 and ending December 31, 2011 regarding Supportive Services Programs for seniors in Albany County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging in the amount of \$332,673 commencing January 1, 2011 and ending December 31, 2011 regarding Supportive Services Programs for seniors in Albany County, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
