BROKERAGE SERVICES FOR ELIGIBLE SENIORS**

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Aging has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the Capital District Transportation Authority regarding transportation services for eligible seniors in Albany County utilizing state transportation grant funds for the term commencing November 1, 2011 and ending October 31, 2012 in the amount of \$319,000, and

WHEREAS, The agreement requires the Capital District Transportation Authority to perform all duties required to serve as the transportation brokerage for the Aging Department including receipt and disposition of transportation requests, transportation vendor network management and coordination of transportation services to deliver quality services at the lowest cost and analysis and reporting of transportation service utilization, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Capital District Transportation Authority regarding transportation services for eligible seniors in Albany County for the term commencing November 1, 2011 and ending October 31, 2012 in an amount not to exceed \$319,000, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
