## DETERMINATION THAT A 3.016 ACRE PARCEL ON BRADT HOLLOW ROAD, TOWN OF BERNE IS NO LONGER REQUIRED FOR PUBLIC USE

WHEREAS, The Albany County Executive has requested this Honorable Body to declare a 3.016 acre parcel on Bradt Hollow Road in the Town of Berne as surplus property no longer required for public use and allow the County to sell the parcel to the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation, the owner of an adjacent parcel of property, and

WHEREAS, The County Executive indicated that the location of the property is completely surrounded by the Partridge Run State Wildlife Management Area and the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation expressed an interest in adding this land to the Partridge Run open space, and

WHEREAS, The County Executive further indicated that the County, which acquired the parcel in 1933, has no public use for said parcel on Bradt Hollow Road, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Legislature declares a 3.016 acre parcel on Bradt Hollow Road in the Town of Berne, tax map number 100-1-6, as surplus property no longer needed for public use, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
