AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CORNELL COOPERATIVE EXTENSION REGARDING THE WEATHERIZATION REFERRAL AND PACKAGING (WRAP) PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Department for Aging and the Department of Social Services has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Cornell Cooperative Extension regarding the Weatherization Referral and Packaging Program in the amount of \$155,123 commencing August 1, 2011 and ending July 31, 2012, and

WHEREAS, The Weatherization Referral and Packaging Program is offered in conjunction with the Federal HEAP program to assist low income eligible renters and homeowners who may also be elderly or handicapped with weatherization and other energy conservation services, and

WHEREAS, That Albany County Cornell Cooperative Extension is designated as the agency to administer said program, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Cornell Cooperative Extension in the amount of \$155,123 commencing August 1, 2011 and ending July 31, 2012 regarding the Weatherization Referral and Packaging Program, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
