AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH HOME AIDE SERVICE OF EASTERN NY, INC. D/B/A EDDY LIFELINE REGARDING THE PROVISION AND MAINTENANCE OF IN-HOME ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT FOR ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Social Services has recommended entering into a service agreement with Home Aide Service of Eastern NY, Inc. d/b/a Eddy Lifeline regarding Personal Emergency Response System services commencing January 1, 2012 and ending December 31, 2012, in the amount of \$114,000, and

WHEREAS, Home Aide Service of Eastern NY, Inc. d/b/a Eddy Lifeline will install and maintain electronic communications equipment in the homes of the frail, elderly or disabled to alert the service provider when an emergency situation requires attention, and

WHEREAS, Eligible clients must be assessed by Adult Service caseworkers who will determine if the use of the Personal Emergency Response System would enhance the care plan allowing the participant to be safely maintained in their own home and reducing or delaying more costly nursing home care, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Home Aide Service of Eastern NY, Inc. d/b/a Eddy Lifeline regarding Personal Emergency Response System services commencing January 1, 2012 and ending December 31, 2012 in an amount not to exceed \$114,000, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
