WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of General Services indicated that funding has been made available from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has requested approval to submit a grant application in the amount of \$869,963 to the NYS Energy Research and Development Authority under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act regarding Energy Improvement Projects at various County Facilities, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that the grant funding will be used to offset the construction costs estimated to be \$1,838,570 for energy improvement projects at the ACNH Laundry Facility, Hall of Records, Spruce Street Garage, Capital District Secure Detention Facility and the Civic Center, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application for funding up to \$869,963 to the NYS Energy Research and Development Authority under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act regarding Energy Improvement Projects at various County Facilities, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said grant application as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
