AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH TRINITY INSTITUTION-HOMER PERKINS CENTER INCORPORATED REGARDING CASE PLANNING PREVENTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families, after an RFP process, has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Trinity Institution-Homer Perkins Center Incorporated regarding prevention services for case planning for the period commencing April 1, 2010 and ending March 31, 2011 in the amount of \$321,200, and

WHEREAS, Trinity Institution-Homer Perkins Center will provide comprehensive case planning and supportive services to families in Albany County with children ages birth through eighteen who are at risk of out of home placement or are returning from foster care, and

WHEREAS, The agreement provides linkage to needed community services and resources for meeting basic food, clothing and shelter needs, child care, parent aide services, comprehensive assessment, case planning, clinical support, emergency assistance and transportation services for families to receive services as well as for Family Court hearings, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Trinity Institution-Homer Perkins Center Incorporated regarding prevention services for case planning for the period commencing April 1, 2010 and ending March 31, 2011 in an amount not to exceed \$321,200, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
