AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH TRINITY INSTITUTION – HOMER PERKINS CENTER, INC. REGARDING THE PROVISION OF CLINICAL PREVENTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families, after an RFP process, has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Trinity Institution-Homer Perkins Center Incorporated regarding the provision of clinical prevention services for the period commencing April 1, 2010 and ending March 31, 2011 in the amount of \$262,800, and

WHEREAS, Trinity Institution-Homer Perkins Center will provide comprehensive clinical prevention services and supportive services to families in Albany County with children ages birth through eighteen who are at risk of out of home placement or are returning from foster care as the result of child abuse/neglect or PINS/JD issues, and

WHEREAS, The agreement provides comprehensive assessment, diagnostic testing, case and specialized therapies to children and their families, needed community services and resources for meeting basic food, clothing and shelter needs, child care, parent aide services, case planning, clinical support, and transportation services for families to receive services as well as for Family Court hearings, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Trinity Institution-Homer Perkins Center Incorporated regarding the provision of clinical prevention services for the period commencing April 1, 2010 and ending March 31, 2011 in the amount of \$262,800, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
