

RESOLUTION NO. 141

DETERMINATION THAT THE REHABILITATION OF CR 152 (OLD NISKAYUNA ROAD) IN THE TOWN OF COLONIE WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT

By Audit and Finance Committee:

WHEREAS, Albany County proposes the rehabilitation of approximately 1.0 miles of an existing 2-lane County highway from Maxwell Road to State Route 155 with no resulting increase in width or travel lanes, and

WHEREAS, The proposed work is subject to the requirements of State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR) pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617, and

WHEREAS, Albany County has assumed the designation of Lead Agency for the purpose of compliance with SEQR, and

WHEREAS, The Albany County Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning, acting on behalf of the Albany County Legislature has reviewed the proposed action and has complied with all applicable administrative and procedural requirements on behalf of the County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Legislature has considered the findings of the Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning and has determined that the proposed project is an unlisted action and will not have a significant effect on the environment, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
