WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Department of Transportation regarding walk-way maintenance for the Mohawk-Hudson Trail in the Corning Preserve, and

WHEREAS, The Deputy Commissioner indicated that the Department of Public Works will be responsible for the maintenance of the asphalt connector, maintenance of pedestrian railing along the asphalt trail connector and landscaping and mowing for a period of fifteen years commencing on the day the agreement is signed, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Department of Transportation regarding walk-way maintenance for the Mohawk-Hudson Trail in the Corning Preserve, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
