

RESOLUTION NO. 207

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH FULLER ROAD MANAGEMENT CORPORATION REGARDING COST SHARING OF DESIGN COSTS FOR THE FULLER ROAD/WASHINGTON AVENUE INTERSECTION PROJECT

By Public Works Committee, Messrs. Clenahan, Commisso and Clay:

WHEREAS, The County Executive has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the Fuller Road Management Corporation regarding sharing of design costs for the Fuller Road/Washington Avenue Intersection Project in the amount of \$1,550,000, and

WHEREAS, Albany County has developed design alternatives for the purpose of improving the geometry of the Washington Avenue and Fuller Road intersection which will improve the movement of traffic, and

WHEREAS, The Fuller Road Management Corporation plans to consolidate and expand the University at Albany College of Nanoscale Science and Engineering campus for nanotechnology research which requires relocating Washington Avenue and accelerating the design for the Fuller Road/Washington Avenue Intersection Project, and

WHEREAS, Federal Transportation funding makes the County subject to a Federal Highway Administration requirement to complete the project within ten years or reimburse all federal funds expended for design, and

WHEREAS, The County Executive indicated that the agreement with Fuller Road Management Corporation requires each to share fifty percent of the liability of the design cost up to \$775,000, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Fuller Road Management Corporation regarding sharing of design costs for the Fuller Road/Washington Avenue Intersection Project in the amount of \$1,550,000, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
