

RESOLUTION NO. 212

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 18 FOR 2010: REIMBURSEMENT FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS PERTAINING TO THE SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS PROGRAM

By Social Services Committee and Mr. Clenahan:

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 448 for 2009, this Honorable Body authorized an agreement with the NYS Department of Health regarding reimbursement for administrative costs pertaining to the Early Intervention Program for the period beginning October 1, 2009 and ending September 30, 2010 in an amount not to exceed \$185,561, and

WHEREAS, The Program provides funding for improvement in coordination and delivery of services for infants and toddlers with disabilities and their families, thus making it easier for them to access the system resulting in a more effective and efficient delivery of services, and

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 18 for 2010, this Honorable Body amended the agreement to reflect an amount not to exceed \$216,814 rather than \$185,561, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families has been notified by the NYS Department of Health that additional funds in the amount of \$1,253 has been allocated for a cost of living adjustment pertaining to the Early Intervention Program, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Resolution No. 18 for 2010 is amended to indicate that the amount of the agreement with the NYS Department of Health regarding the Early Intervention Program is in the amount not to exceed \$218,067 rather than \$216,814, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
