

**RESOLUTION NO. 220**

**AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS OFFICE OF  
HOMELAND SECURITY REGARDING PUBLIC HEALTH PREPAREDNESS  
AND RESPONSE CAPABILITIES**

By Public Safety Committee, Messrs. Clenahan and Scavo:

WHEREAS, The County Executive has been notified by the New York State Office of Homeland Security that Federal funds in the amount of \$330,800 are available over three years to enhance the County's prevention, preparedness and response capabilities to combat potential terrorist threats, and

WHEREAS, The Executive has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the New York State Office of Homeland Security for the period beginning August 1, 2010 through July 31, 2014 to strengthen the County's prevention, preparedness and response capabilities in the event of a terrorist attack involving the use of chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear and explosive weapons and cyber attacks, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the New York State Office of Homeland Security for the period August 1, 2010 through July 31, 2014 in the amount of \$330,800 to enhance the County's prevention, preparedness and response capabilities in the event of a terrorist attack, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
