AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A FINANCING APPLICATION TO THE NYS ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITIES CORPORATION REGARDING THE SEWER DISTRICT'S NORTH AND SOUTH PLANT EFFLUENT DISINFECTION PROJECT

By Audit and Finance Committee, Mr. Clenahan and Ms. McKnight:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sewer District proposes to install various equipment necessary to implement the disinfection of coliform/pathogens at the North and South Plant as mandated under modifications to the Sewer District's State Pollution Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) permit, and

WHEREAS, The project will improve water quality in the Hudson River by reducing coliform bacteria and its completion is in the best interests of all Albany County residents, and

WHEREAS, The Executive Director of the Sewer District has requested authorization to submit a financial assistance application to the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation in order to secure a two year interest free loan for the project, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to execute all necessary documents to submit a financial assistance application to the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation for the North and South Plant Effluent Disinfection Project, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
