

RESOLUTION NO. 259

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS HEALTH DEPARTMENT REGARDING AMERICAN RECOVERY FUNDING FOR THE IMMUNIZATION ACTION PLAN AND AMENDING THE 2010 HEALTH DEPARTMENT BUDGET

By Health Committee, Messrs. Clenahan and Cotrofeld:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Health has been notified by the NYS Department of Health that funding in the amount of \$47,633 is available to provide services in support of the Immunization Action Plan through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has requested authorization to enter into an agreement to receive the funding and to amend the 2010 Health Department Budget to incorporate a portion of said funding, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Department of Health regarding funding for the Immunization Action Plan through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act commencing October 1, 2009 through March 31, 2011 in an amount not to exceed \$47,633, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2010 Health Department Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account 4407 Immunization Action Plan Grant by \$9,200

Increase Appropriation Account A4010.2 by \$5,000 by increasing the following line items:

Increase Line Item A4010.2.2050 Computer Equipment by \$3,000

Increase Line Item A4010.2.2080 Specialty Equipment by \$2,000

Increase Appropriation Account A4010.4 by \$4,200 by increasing the following line items:

Increase Line Item A4010.4.4023 Medical Supplies by \$2,700

Increase Line Item A4010.4.4039 Conferences Training Tuition by \$500

Increase Line Item A4010.4.4042 Printing and Advertising by \$1,000

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
