

RESOLUTION NO. 265

AMENDING THE 2010 SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT BUDGET: FUNDING REGARDING PUBLIC HEALTH PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE CAPABILITIES

By Public Safety Committee and Mr. McCoy:

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 220 for 2010, this Honorable Body authorized an agreement with the New York State Office of Homeland Security that Federal funds in the amount of \$330,800 to enhance the County's prevention, preparedness and response capabilities to combat potential terrorist threats, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department has requested a budget amendment to incorporate a portion of the grant funding into the 2010 Sheriff's Department Budget to be used to strengthen the County's prevention, preparedness and response capabilities in the event of a terrorist attack involving the use of chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear and explosive weapons and cyber attacks, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the 2010 Sheriff's Department Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A3306 Homeland Security by \$220,800

Increase Appropriation Account A3110. 2 by \$144,000 by increasing Line Item A3110 2 2750 Security Equipment by \$144,000

Increase Appropriation Account A3110. 4 by \$76,800 by increasing Line Item A3110 4 4046 Fees For Services by \$76,800

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
