WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has been notified that his Department has been awarded a Homeland Security grant totaling \$37,000, including a Department match of \$9,250, to enhance the County's ability to respond to emergencies on the Hudson River including the Port of Albany, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has requested authorization to enter into an agreement to receive the grant funding and a budget amendment to incorporate the grant funding into the 2010 department budget, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Port Authority of NY and NJ regarding a Homeland Security grant totaling \$37,000 to enhance the County's ability to respond to emergencies on the Hudson River including the Port of Albany, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2010 Sheriff's Department Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A4306 Homeland Security by \$27,750

Increase Appropriation Account A3110. 2 by \$27,750 by increasing Line Item A3110 2 2400 Automobiles by \$27,750

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
