WHEREAS, The Deputy Commissioner of the Department of Public Works has requested approval to submit a grant application for up to \$20,000 to the Greenway Conservancy for the Hudson River Valley, Inc. regarding the Rail Trail Project, and

WHEREAS, The Deputy Commissioner indicated that the funding would be used for guide signs, minor shoulder and sidewalk improvements to connect the Albany County Rail Trail and to guide users to the western trail head from NY 155 and NY 85A, and

WHEREAS, The Deputy Commissioner further indicated that, if successful, the grant requires that Albany County provide a 100% match of the amount awarded, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application for funding up to \$20,000 to the Greenway Conservancy for the Hudson River Valley, Inc. regarding the Rail Trail Project, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said grant application as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
