**APPOINTMENT OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS FOR TWO YEAR
TERMS**

By Mr. Commisso and Ms. Benedict:

WHEREAS, In accordance with Section 3-202 of the New York State Election Law, this Honorable Body may determine that the term of office of the Election Commissioners be for a period of two years, and

WHEREAS, The Clerk of the Albany County Legislature has received certificates from the respective political parties recommending James M. Clancy, a qualified voter of the County of Albany and a fit and proper person, be appointed as Democratic Commissioner of Elections and John A. Graziano, Sr., a qualified voter of the County of Albany and a fit and proper person, be appointed as Republican Commissioner of Elections in accordance with the provisions of Section 3-204 of the Election Law, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By this Honorable Body, pursuant to the provisions of Section 3-204 of the Election Law, that James M. Clancy and John A. Graziano, Sr. be and hereby are appointed as Election Commissioners of the County of Albany for a term commencing January 1, 2007 and ending December 31, 2008, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
