DETERMINATION THAT THE REHABILITATION OF CR156 (FULLER ROAD) IN THE TOWNS OF GUILDERLAND AND COLONIE AND THE CITY OF ALBANY WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT

WHEREAS, Albany County proposes to rehabilitate approximately 1.9 miles of CR156 (Fuller Road) from State Route 20 (Western Avenue) to State Route 5 (Central Avenue), excluding the Fuller Road/Washington Avenue/Washington Avenue Extension intersection and approach lanes proposed for replacement by a two-lane roundabout, and to install sidewalks and bicycle facilities, replace curbs and modify the existing drainage system to conform with current stormwater regulations and, if necessary, underground water and sewer lines, and

WHEREAS, The proposed action is subject to the requirements of State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR) pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617, and

WHEREAS, Albany County has assumed the designation of Lead Agency for the purpose of compliance with SEQR for this unlisted action, and

WHEREAS, The Albany County Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning, acting on behalf of the Albany County Legislature has reviewed the proposed action and has complied with all applicable administrative and procedural requirements on behalf of the County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Legislature has considered the findings of the Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning and has determined that the proposed action will not have a significant effect on the environment, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
