

RESOLUTION NO. 454

DETERMINATION THAT THE PROPOSED RECONFIGURATION OF THE EXISTING INTERSECTION OF CR156 (FULLER ROAD), WASHINGTON AVENUE AND WASHINGTON AVENUE EXTENSION WITH A TWO-LANE ROUNDABOUT WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT

By Audit and Finance Committee, Messrs. Clay, Commisso and Reilly:

WHEREAS, Albany County, acting on a project approved by the Capital District Transportation Committee, proposes to reconfigure the existing four-leg intersection of CR156 (Fuller Road), Washington Avenue and Washington Avenue Extension with a two-lane roundabout, including improvements to the approach lanes and updating the existing drainage system to conform to current stormwater regulations, and

WHEREAS, The proposed action is subject to the requirements of State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR) pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617, and

WHEREAS, Albany County has assumed the designation of Lead Agency for the purpose of compliance with SEQR for this unlisted action, and

WHEREAS, The Albany County Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning, acting on behalf of the Albany County Legislature has reviewed the proposed action and has complied with all applicable administrative and procedural requirements on behalf of the County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Legislature has considered the findings of the Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning and has determined that the proposed action will not have a significant effect on the environment, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
