AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH REGARDING THE HEALTHY NEIGHBORHOODS PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Health has been notified by the NYS Department of Health that Albany County has been awarded \$100,000 in grant funding to continue the Healthy Neighborhoods Program, and

WHEREAS, The grant enables the Department to provide preventive environmental health services in targeted neighborhoods with high percentages of older housing stock, focusing on tobacco cessation, asthma, indoor air quality, fire safety and lead poisoning prevention, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Department of Health regarding the Healthy Neighborhoods Program for the period from October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007 in the amount of \$100,000, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Department of Health in the amount of \$100,000 commencing October 1, 2006 and ending September 30, 2007 regarding the Healthy Neighborhoods Program, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
