AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CORRECTIONAL MEDICAL SERVICES, INC. REGARDING MEDICAL CARE AT THE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY

By Audit and Finance and Public Safety Committees:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has requested authorization for a three-year agreement with Correctional Medical Services, Inc. to provide comprehensive medical care to the inmate population at the Albany County Correctional Facility, and

WHEREAS, The Albany County Purchasing Department issued an RFP for inmate medical care at the Correctional Facility and three bids were received, and

WHEREAS, The three responding providers were interviewed by an evaluation committee comprised of personnel from the County Attorney's Office, the Sheriff's Department and the Correctional Facility, and

WHEREAS, An extensive evaluation was conducted and as a result, the committee has recommended contracting with Correctional Medical Services, Inc., which has provided health care services at the County facility since April 1, 2002, as the vendor which would offer the best value and the most comprehensive service to the inmate population at the Correctional Facility, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into a three-year agreement for inmate medical care at the Albany County Correctional Facility with Correctional Medical Services, Inc., 12647 Olive Boulevard, St. Louis, MO, as follows: a term beginning January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007 at a sum of \$3,985,401; a term beginning January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008 at a sum of \$4,185,153; and a term beginning January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009 at a sum of \$4,393,919, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to review said agreement as to form and content, and

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
