WHEREAS, The Albany County District Attorney has requested authorization to submit a grant application with the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services regarding the Operation IMPACT Tools Program, and

WHEREAS, The District Attorney has indicated that the State grant in the amount of \$60,000 will be directed to smaller law enforcement agencies in Albany County to improve crime enforcement strategies and violence prevention initiatives, and

WHEREAS, The District Attorney indicates that the Operation IMPACT Tools Program also will enhance countywide communications and information sharing between local and state law enforcement agencies, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application with the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services regarding the Operation IMPACT Tools Program in the amount of \$60,000, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said application and agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
