

RESOLUTION NO. 286

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH FAMILIES TOGETHER NEW YORK REGARDING SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Families Together New York regarding Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services for the period beginning October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007 in the amount of \$1,524,571, and

WHEREAS, Families Together New York is the statewide leader in parent support, advocacy and the Department's lead partner responsible for the oversight and staffing of three Family Resource Centers under development, and

WHEREAS, Families Together New York offers family support, respite, information and referrals, training and supervision of parent advisors for the Across the Ages Mentoring Program and information linkage to respite services, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has indicated that funds for the agreement will come from the third year of a \$9.4 million six-year grant award to Albany County from the Federal Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Families Together New York regarding Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services for the period beginning October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007 in the amount of \$1,524,571, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
