WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Aging has been notified by the NYS Office for the Aging that funds are available to administer the Weatherization Assistance Program for Seniors, and

WHEREAS, Said program provides weatherization, labor and materials for dwelling units occupied by low income elderly persons, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Aging has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging in the amount of \$75,903 commencing August 1, 2006 and ending July 31, 2007 regarding the Weatherization Assistance Program for Seniors, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Aging has also requested a budget amendment in order to incorporate the aforementioned funding into the Department for Aging Budget, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging in the amount of \$75,903 commencing August 1, 2006 and ending July 31, 2007 regarding the Weatherization Program for Seniors, and, be it further

RESOLVED, In order to incorporate the above funding, that the 2006 Department for Aging Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A4772 Programs for the Aging by \$75,903

Increase Appropriation Account A6772.4 by \$75,903 by increasing Line Item A6772 4 4046 000 Fees for Services by \$75,903

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
