

RESOLUTION NO. 184

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CALLANAN INDUSTRIES INC. REGARDING THE HAULING AND PLACING OF ASPHALT ON VARIOUS COUNTY ROADS AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 133 FOR 2006

By Public Works Committee and Mr. Messercola:

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 133 for 2006, this Honorable Body authorized an agreement with Cobleskill Stone Products, Inc. regarding the hauling and placing of asphalt on various county roads, and

WHEREAS, Subsequent to the approval of Resolution No. 133 for 2006, the County Attorney received information indicating that Cobleskill Stone Products, Inc. was not a responsible vendor, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Albany County Department of Public Works presented the Public Works Committee with said information and upon its review the Committee determined that Cobleskill Stone Products, Inc. was not a responsible bidder, and

WHEREAS, The Public Works Committee recommended that Callanan Industries Inc., the lowest responsible bidder, should be awarded the contract for hauling and placing of asphalt on various county roads in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Resolution No. 133 for 2006 is hereby rescinded, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Callanan Industries Inc., 1245 Kings Road, Schenectady, NY 12303 in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 regarding the hauling and placing of asphalt on various county roads, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
