

**RESOLUTION NO. 137**

**AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS OFFICE FOR THE AGING REGARDING THE EXPANDED IN-HOME SERVICES FOR THE ELDERLY PROGRAM (EISEP) AND AMENDING THE 2006 DEPARTMENT FOR AGING BUDGET**

By Social Services Committee, Messrs. Riddick and Domalewicz:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Aging has been notified by the NYS Office for the Aging that funds are available for provisions of the Expanded In-Home Services for the Elderly Program, and

WHEREAS, The Expanded In-Home Services for the Elderly Program provides attendants for home care visits of homebound elderly to tend to personal health needs and assessments, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging regarding the Expanded In-Home Services for the Elderly Program commencing April 1, 2006 and ending March 31, 2007 in the amount of \$1,077,360, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has also requested a budget amendment in order to appropriate \$164,113 of financial assistance to enhance the Department's funding for the Expanded In-Home Services for the Elderly Program, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging in the amount of \$1,077,360 commencing April 1, 2006 and ending March 31, 2007 regarding the Expanded In-Home Services for the Elderly Program, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2006 Department for Aging Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A3772 Programs for the Aging by \$164,113

Increase Appropriation Account A6772.4 by \$164,113 by increasing Line Item A6772 4 4046 000 Fees For Services by \$164,113

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
