WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Aging has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging in the amount of \$330,515 commencing January 1, 2006 and ending December 31, 2006 regarding Supportive Services Programs for seniors in Albany County, now, therefore be it
