AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH GIRLS INCORPORATED OF THE GREATER CAPITAL REGION REGARDING ADOLESCENT PREGNANCY PREVENTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, Pregnancy Prevention Services, Project Options Program is an adolescent and preadolescent pregnancy prevention program whose primary goal is to educate youths between 10 and 19 years of age by supplying information regarding alternatives to teenage parenthood through counseling and preventive education, by incorporating knowledge of basic living skills and placing particular emphasis on the importance of education, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families after an RFP process has recommended Girls Incorporated of the Greater Capital Region to provide pregnancy prevention services commencing May 1, 2006 and ending April 30, 2009, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has requested authorization to enter into the first year agreement commencing May 1, 2006 and ending April 30, 2007 in an amount not to exceed \$140,000, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Girls Incorporated of the Greater Capital Region commencing May 1, 2006 and ending April 30, 2007 in an amount not to exceed \$140,000, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
