

RESOLUTION NO. 108

**AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 393 FOR 2003 REGARDING
ARCHITECTURAL/ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE CONSTRUCTION
AND RENOVATION OF THE ALBANY COUNTY NURSING HOME**

By Social Services and Audit and Finance Committees and Ms. McKnight:

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 393 for 2003, this Honorable Body amended the County's agreement with DeWolff Partnership Architects to provide architectural and engineering services for the Albany County nursing home facilities construction project, and

WHEREAS, Since that time, the NYS Health Department has unilaterally amended Albany County's Certificate of Need from 480 beds to a 450-bed facility, and as a contingency for approval is requiring the County to reflect the change in its Certificate of Need documents, and

WHEREAS, As part of the project revision necessitated by the amended Certificate of Need and to meet the additional cost, the County Executive and the Executive Director of the Department of Residential Health Care Services have requested approval of an amendment to the agreement with DeWolff Partnership Architects, 151 St. Paul Street, Rochester, New York, adding \$81,917 which includes \$45,000 for architectural/engineering services and \$36,917 for DeWolff subcontractor Hartgen Archeological Associates to conduct Phase II archeological investigation work on the Heritage Park site, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That Resolution No. 393 for 2003 is amended to reflect that the amount of the agreement with DeWolff Partnership Architects is \$2,421,905.40 rather than \$2,339,988.40, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said amendment to the agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
