WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 207 for 2005, this Honorable Body authorized an agreement with Capital Digitronics in the sum of \$1,115,257.33 regarding the purchase and installation of equipment for the Albany County Incident Control and Command Interoperable Radio System, and

WHEREAS, The interoperable system along with improvements to the current emergency radio system are being financed from a portion of a Department of Homeland Security grant awarded the County under the Urban Area Security Initiative, and

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff indicated that additional services are required of Capital Digitronics in order to complete the project, and

WHEREAS, As a result of substantiated claims for additional services and work performed by the contractor, the Sheriff has requested authorization to pay a change order totaling \$41,627, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Resolution No. 207 for 2005 is amended to reflect that the authorized amount of the agreement with Capital Digitronics is \$1,156,884.33 rather than \$1,115,257.33 regarding the installation of equipment and services for the Albany County Incident Control and Command Interoperable Radio System, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said amended agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
