WHEREAS, Revenues from the recording tax help relieve the burdens placed on local property taxpayers, and

WHEREAS, Currently, bills entitled, "An act to amend chapter 405 of the laws of 2005 amending the tax law relating to authorizing the county of Albany to impose a county recording tax on obligations secured by a mortgage on real property, in relation to extending the effectiveness thereof" are before both houses of the New York State Legislature: in the Assembly Bill No. A.7117, and in the Senate, Bill No. S.6762, now, therefore, be it

PURPOSE:

Extends the effectiveness of chapter 58 of the laws of 2020 for one year.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS:

Extends the Albany County Hotel Tax sunset from December 31, 2023 to December 31, 2024. The bill enables the county of Albany to impose and collect taxes on occupancy of hotel or motel rooms in Albany County relating to revenues received from the collection of hotel or motel occupancy taxes.

JUSTIFICATION:

Currently, the county of Albany's hotel/motel occupancy tax is slated to sunset on December 31, 2023. For the county to continue generating revenue, the sunset must be extended. This ensures the continued promotion of the Capital District and provides funding for the continuation of the Albany Capital Center.
