Due to the increased demand and need for HDM within Albany County has increased the need for 997.75 additional assessment units/hours.

Department for Aging (DFA) operates a home delivered meal program for the older adults in Albany County designed to foster good health through the provision of home delivered meals and adult day services. Over the past year, Department of Social Services (DSS) has performed the required assessments and reassessments for older adults referred to the Home Delivered Meal program, which has provided meals to eligible homebound frail older adults in Albany County.

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Aging has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the New York State Office for the Aging regarding the Wellness in Nutrition Program in the amount of \$492,410 for the term commencing April 1, 2022 and ending March 31, 2023, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has also requested authorization to enter into an interdepartmental agreement with the Department of Social Services to provide assessment services, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has indicated that the funding will be used by the Department for Aging in conjunction with the Albany County Department of Social Services to provide home-delivered meal services to eligible seniors in Albany County, as well as the assessments required for the provision of those meals, now, therefore, be it
