Veterans & Retirees See Record Pay Increase

VA is increasing compensation payment rates based on the latest <u>cost-of-living ad-justment (COLA) announcement</u>. Beginning Jan. 1, 2023, Veterans and beneficiaries who receive VA compensation benefits are receiving an 8.7% increase in their monthly payments—the largest increase in over 30 years.

The annual <u>COLA</u> increase is tied to the Social Security rate change and is based on the <u>consumer price index</u> (CPI). The CPI, provided by the U.S. Department of Labor, measures the average changes in cost for urban goods and services. The Department of Labor takes a snapshot of the costs of a select group of goods and services and compares those costs to the previous year. When there is an increase, those receiving benefits see a boost in their monthly payments for the upcoming year.

If you are receiving disability compensation benefits from VA, you can use VA disability compensation benefit rates tables to <u>find your current monthly payment amount.</u>

Military retirement, VA Disability Compensation, Dependency and Indemnity Compensation, and special benefit allowances will all see increases.







Return The F.A.V.O.R. Discount For Veterans

Return the F.A.V.O.R. (Find & Assist Veterans of Record) is a merchant discount program for eligible Albany County Veterans. The program provides veterans with a discount on services or purchases at participating merchants.

Veterans can enroll by bringing their DD-214 to the Albany County Veterans Service Bureau office Monday through Friday 9am to 4pm. Please call for an appointment to ensure availability and timely service.

Calls to Veterans Crisis Line Spike Over New Year Holiday

The number of calls from Veterans and their family members to the VA suicide prevention hotline spiked over the New Year's holiday, news that department officials are saying shows increase awareness and accessibility of the emergency service. Over the two-day weekend, the Veterans Crisis Line fielded 3,869 calls, up almost 19% from typical weekend levels so far this fiscal year.

The Veterans Crisis Line connects Service members and Veterans in crisis, as well as their family members and friends, with qualified, caring VA responders through a confidential toll-free hotline, online chat, or text-messaging service. This free support is confidential and available every day, 24/7, to all Veterans, all service members, National Guard & Reserve, family members & friends.

Free Training Programs Offer Path to Tech Careers

Veterans and their spouses are eligible for free training programs offered by <u>NPower</u>.

NPower's program has served more than 1,600 Veterans and military spouses with free tech training, professional development, social and mental health support, assistance navigating VA benefits, paid learning opportunities and job placements – all for aiding participants into a successful career in tech.

Veterans often possess sharp technical skills and have experience with complex equipment. Easy Access to VA Products, Services

Login.gov is a U.S. government service that provides seamless access to government websites. A Login.gov account allows you to use the same email and password to access VA.gov, My HealtheVet, VA/DoD Ebenefits and the VA Health and Benefits mobile app. Plus, you can securely sign in to USAJOBS and TSA pre-check, and apply for SBA small business loans and disaster aid.

Important Documents & Information When Applying for Benefits

- Honorable Discharge from the Armed Forces or Report of Military Separation (DD-214)
- Record of Marriage
- Birth certificate or adoption papers for dependent children
- Death Certificate of Veteran & any previous spouse
- Divorce Papers
- Veterans social security number
- Department of Veterans Affairs claim or file number
- Annual family income information (wages, retirement, interest, etc.)

All Documents listed above may be copied, except for the DD-214, which must be a certified copy.

The Defense Commissary Agency (DeCA) has been hard at work spreading the news to Veterans about their ability to shop at <u>commissaries</u>. Working with Veteran Service Organizations to promote, inform and gather feedback amongst the Veteran community about this privilege has proven effective. Engaging with Veterans, DeCA has learned that while many are now utilizing this benefit, others still are unaware. <u>Verify your eligibility</u> for this exclusive benefit.

Commissary shopping privileges are available to the following groups:

- ► Veterans with any service-connected disabilities documented by VA
- ► Veterans who are Purple Heart recipients
- Veterans who are former prisoners of war
- Individuals assessed, approved and designated as the primary family caregivers of eligible Veterans under VA's Program of Comprehensive Assistance for Family Caregivers

Contact the installation where you intend to shop; inquire about their current policies regarding installation access.
