NYS FreshConnect Checks

In collaboration with the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets and NYS Department of Veterans' Services, Veteran Service Officers for each County are offering FreshConnect checks to Active Duty members, Veterans and their immediate family members, as well as un-remarried surviving spouses of Veterans.

Albany County residents who are Veterans and their immediate family members are eligible to receive FreshConnect checks from the Albany County Veteran Services Bureau. Recipients will receive a booklet of FreshConnect checks worth a total of \$50 to be used for fresh produce and other food items at participating farmers markets throughout New York State. We have a limited supply of FreshConnect checks which will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis. If you would like FreshConnect checks, contact our office at (518) 447-7713. The FreshConnect "season" generally begins in July and runs until December. Only one booklet of checks may be obtained per Veteran household.







Return The F.A.V.O.R. Discount For Veterans

Return the F.A.V.O.R. (Find & Assist Veterans of Record) is a merchant discount program for eligible Albany County Veterans. The program provides veterans with a discount on services or purchases at participating merchants.

Veterans can enroll by bringing their DD-214 to the Albany County Veterans Service Bureau office Monday through Friday 9am to 4pm. Please call for an appointment to ensure availability and timely service.

Important Documents & Information When Applying for Benefits

- Honorable Discharge from the Armed Forces or Report of Military Separation (DD-214)
- · Record of Marriage
- Birth certificate or adoption papers for dependent children
- Death Certificate of Veteran & any previous spouse
- Divorce Papers
- Veterans social security number
- Department of Veterans Affairs claim or file number
- Annual family income information (wages, retirement, interest, etc.)

All Documents listed above may be copied, except for the DD-214, which must be a certified copy.

NY Lifetime Liberty Pass free vehicle entry to state parks and DEC-operated day-use areas, as well as numerous state boat launch sites, historic sites, arboretums and park preserves; free golf at 28 State Park golf courses; free swimming pool entrance at 36 State Park pools, and discounted camping and cabin rentals at all 119 State Park and DEC campgrounds.

<u>Veterans, Gold Star Families Lifetime National Parks Pass</u> free entrance to national parks for Veterans and their families. The pass gives free access to about 2,000 public locations spread out across more than 400 million acres of public lands.
