AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 37 FOR 2016 REGARDING THE NYS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH INDOOR RADON GRANT PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CORNELL COOPERATIVE EXTENSION

By Health Committee:

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 37 of 2016 this Honorable body authorized an agreement with the NYS Department of Health, Bureau of Environmental Radiation Protection regarding the Indoor Radon Grant Program for the period beginning July 1, 2015 and ending June 30, 2020 in the amount of \$37,865, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Albany County Department of Health of (ACDOH) has been notified by the NYS Department of Health, Bureau of Environmental Radiation Protection that funds for the five-year Indoor Radon Grant Program have been increased by \$26,605 to an amount not to exceed \$64,470 rather than \$37,865, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of ACDOH has indicated that the Radon Grant would continue funding for educational programs and home visits to inspect and test radon levels and indoor air quality, directed especially at residents living in areas of the County known to have high levels of radon present, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of ACDOH has requested to enter into a contract with Cornell Cooperative Extension to support radon program deliverables for the period beginning July 1, 2015 and ending June 30, 2020 for the amount of \$57,800, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Resolution No. 37 for 2016 is amended to indicate that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an amended agreement with the NYS Department of Health, Bureau of Environmental Radiation Protection regarding an Indoor Radon Grant Program for the period beginning July 1, 2015 and ending June 30, 2020 in an amount not to exceed \$64,470, and be it further

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Cornell Cooperative Extension to support radon program deliverables for the period beginning July 1, 2015 and ending June 30, 2020 for the amount not to exceed \$57,800, and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
