

RESOLUTION NO. 122

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MOHAWK HUDSON LAND CONSERVANCY REGARDING ACCEPTING SPONSORED BENCHES FOR THE ALBANY COUNTY RAIL TRAIL

By Public Works Committee:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Recreation has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the Mohawk Hudson Land Conservancy, Inc. regarding accepting sponsored benches for the Albany County Rail Trail, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated the agreement will allow acceptance of sponsored personalized benches (that are marketed at a sponsorship cost equal to the cost of the bench plus any sponsorship indicia affixed to the bench) through the Mohawk Hudson Land Conservancy, Inc. by the County to beautify the Rail Trail, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Mohawk Hudson Land Conservancy, Inc. regarding accepting sponsored benches for the Albany County Rail Trail pursuant to the terms as aforesaid, and be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
