WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Recreation has requested authorization to accept a little library on the Albany County Rail Trail in the vicinity of the Adams Street and Hudson Avenue intersection in Delmar at no cost to the County, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated the little library, a large mailbox-like structure, would be donated to the county and maintained by Ms. Kristie Mahan after being installed by the County Department of Public Works allowing Rail Trail users to stop and read books or take books home to return at a later date, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to accept a little library on the Albany County Rail Trail in the vicinity of the Adams Street and Hudson Avenue intersection in Delmar at no cost to the County, and be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
