

**RESOLUTION NO. 193**

**AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH REGARDING A RABIES CONTROL PROGRAM AND AMENDING THE 2017 HEALTH DEPARTMENT BUDGET**

Introduced: 5/8/17  
By Health Committee:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Health Department has been notified by the NYS Department of Health that its Rabies Control Program has been approved for continuation in the amount of \$98,144, and

WHEREAS, The purpose of the program is to reimburse Albany County for actual expenses for certain expenditures related to rabies control including, but not limited to, mandatory human rabies treatment, preparation and shipment of animal specimens, pet vaccination clinics and education prevention activities, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Health has also requested a budget amendment in order to appropriate an additional \$1,838 of funding into the Department's 2017 budget, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into a multi-year agreement with the NYS Department of Health, Bureau of Communicable Diseases for the continuation of the Rabies Control Program as set forth above, in the amount of \$98,144 for the period beginning April 1, 2017 and ending March 31, 2019, and, be it further

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the 2017 Albany County Health Department budget is amended, as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A4415 Rabies Grant by \$1,838

Increase Appropriation Account A4010.4 by \$1,838 by increasing Line Item A4010 4 4023 Medical Supplies by \$1,838

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
