WHEREAS, The Executive Director of Residential Health Care Facilities has requested authorization to enter into a three-year agreement with Stanley Convergent Security Solutions regarding a service plan for all installed security equipment at the Nursing Home in an amount not to exceed \$24,000 for the period commencing August 1, 2017 and ending July 31, 2020, and

WHEREAS, The Executive Director indicated the Stanley Standard Service Plan covers labor and equipment costs associated with the repair and replacement of protection systems including intrusion alarms, fire alarms, camera systems and access control systems at a cost of approximately \$8,000 per year, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into a three-year agreement with Stanley Convergent Security Solutions regarding a service plan for all installed security equipment at the Nursing Home in an amount not to exceed \$24,000 for the period commencing August 1, 2017 and ending July 31, 2020, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
