AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CORNELL COOPERATIVE EXTENSION TO PROVIDE TRAINING COURSES FOR LEAD BASED PAINT REMEDIATION CERTIFICATION

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Health has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Cornell Cooperative Extension to provide renovation, repair and painting (RRP) training courses for individuals who may need to be certified to perform lead based paint remediation, and

WHEREAS, Cornell Cooperative Extension is certified by the Environmental Protection Agency to provide RRP training courses and will provide twelve RRP initial courses, four RRP refresher courses, and four window replacement trainings in an amount not to exceed \$45,000 commencing April 1, 2017 and ending March 31, 2018, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Cornell Cooperative Extension to provide renovation, repair and painting (RRP) training courses for individuals who need to be certified to perform lead based paint remediation in an amount not to exceed \$45,000 commencing April 1, 2017 and ending March 31, 2018, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
