

RESOLUTION NO. 243

AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS REGARDING THE LEASE OF FIVE DEFIBRILLATORS FOR THE PARTICIPATING TOWNS IN THE ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT PROGRAM

By Public Safety Committee:

WHEREAS, Automated external defibrillators are portable, laptop-sized devices that analyze heart rhythms and deliver an electric shock to the heart when necessary, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has indicated that there is a need to lease five automated external defibrillators for the participating towns in the Advanced Life Support Program whereby the County provides emergency medical services in Albany County through agreements with participating towns requiring financial contributions, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department reviewed and evaluated the various contractors providing said service under New York State Contract and has suggested that Stryker Sales Corporation offers the best value for Albany County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into a lease agreement with Stryker Sales Corporation for a five year term commencing June 15, 2017 and ending June 14, 2022 in accordance with the submitted proposal regarding the lease-purchase of five automated external defibrillators for the participating towns in the Advanced Life Support Program for an amount not to exceed \$168,950 over the term of the contract which will be reimbursed by the towns, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the agreement shall include a buyout option, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
