

RESOLUTION NO. 483

APPOINTMENT OF A MEMBER TO THE ALBANY COUNTY HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION

WHEREAS, By Local Law No. 1 for 1996, as amended by Local Law No. 1 for 2000 and Local Law No. 1 for 2013, this Honorable Body adopted “An Omnibus Human Rights Law for Albany County,” and

WHEREAS, The aforementioned Local Law establishes a Commission of nine members appointed by the Albany County Legislature to serve at the pleasure of the Legislature, to carry out the County’s human rights policy, and

WHEREAS, The Majority Leader has recommended the appointment of Mr. Michael Hurt, who has expressed an interest in becoming a member of the Human Rights Commission and his credentials confirm he would be a valuable contributor to the Commission, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Mr. Michael Hurt, 60 East Poplar Drive, Delmar, New York, 12054, is hereby appointed to the Albany County Human Rights Commission to serve at the pleasure of the Legislature, and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
