## **RESOLUTION NO. 510**

AUTHORIZING A LEASE AGREEMENT FOR THE RENTAL OF COMMERCIAL SPACE AT THE TIMES UNION CENTER: JOSEPHINE SAPIENZA DBA PIZZERIA SAPIENZA

By Civic Center Committee:

WHEREAS, Josephine Sapienza, DBA Pizzeria Sapienza, 51 South Pearl Street, Albany, New York 12207 (tenant) has worked in collaboration with the Albany County Attorney's Office and the Regional General Manager of SMG and proposes to renew their lease of the 1,345 square feet of commercial space in the front entry plaza of the Times Union Center for a pizzeria, and

WHEREAS, The proposed term of the lease is for five years, beginning June 1, 2017 and ending May 31, 2022, with an increase of \$1 per square foot, which results in an annual rent of \$21,520 for the term, payable in equal monthly installments of \$1,793, with one additional five-year mutual renewal option, and

WHEREAS, A Letter of Understanding was produced between the Albany County Attorney and Scott M. Morley, Esq. of Martin, Shudt, Wallace, DiLorenzo & Johnson, the attorneys representing the tenant, Josephine Sapienza, DBA Pizzeria Sapienza, which established that the tenant would be able to rent on a month-to-month basis until renovation plans were submitted and approved by the County, the tenant has agreed to perform \$25,000 worth of renovations, at their expense, for the 1,345 square feet of commercial space located in the front entryway of the Times Union Center, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into a lease renewal with Josephine Sapienza, DBA Pizzeria Sapienza, for the period beginning June 1, 2017 and ending May 31, 2022, pursuant to the terms as set forth above, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said lease agreement as to form and content prior to the execution thereof, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
